SHOPS

Food shops typically open at o6.00 a.m. and work until 09.00 p.m., both weekdays and Saturdays. Sundays they typically operate from o6.00 a.m. to 02.00 p.m. Shopping malls are open from 09.00 a.m. to o8.oo p.m. Everywhere, there are stores open 24 hours a day. Markets are opened every day from o6.oo a.m. to o5.oo p.m.



There is a VAT (PDV) of 8 - 18% depending on the kinds of goods or services.

MEDICAL CARE

Hospitals and out-patient clinics typically work 24 hours a day. Private medical practices are common and emergency medical service is available everywhere 24 hours a day. Pharmacies are opened from o8.oo a.m. to o8.oo p.m. on working days and on Saturdays from o8.00 a.m. to o3.00 p.m. Each city has a pharmacy that is open on Sundays and throughout the night. 


PASSPORTS AND VISAS

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
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










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
