 Climate: Temperate continental climate, with warm Summers up to 33°C and snowy winters with average temperatures from - 5°C to 10°C  
 Time: GMT + 1 (March-October GMT+2)  
 Currency: Dinar (RSD) 1 Dinar = 100 para  
 Power supply: 220 V, 50 Hz  
 Water supply: Water is supplied by city water-works and water from public fountains is potable.

## SHOPS

Food shops typically open at 06.00 a.m. and work until 09.00 p.m., both weekdays and Saturdays. Sundays they typically operate from 06.00 a.m. to 02.00 p.m. Shopping malls are open from 09.00 a.m. to 08.00 p.m. Everywhere, there are stores open 24 hours a day. Markets are opened every day from 06.00 a.m. to 05.00 p.m.

## TAX

There is a VAT (PDV) of 8 – 18% depending on the kinds of goods or services.

## MEDICAL CARE

Hospitals and out-patient clinics typically work 24 hours a day. Private medical practices are common and emergency medical service is available everywhere 24 hours a day. Pharmacies are opened from 08.00 a.m. to 08.00 p.m. on working days and on Saturdays from 08.00 a.m. to 03.00 p.m. Each city has a pharmacy that is open on Sundays and throughout the night.

## FUEL

Gas stations on major roads and in major cities are open 24 hours a day. Drivers can purchase 05-98 octane gasoline (super), unleaded gasoline, diesel and oil (locally produced or imported). Liquefied petroleum gas can be purchased at most major gas stations.  
 National drivers licenses are valid in Serbia.

## RAILWAYS

Railroads in Serbia comprise 3,800 km, standard gauge (1435 mm). Railroads connect all parts of the country as well as other parts of Europe.

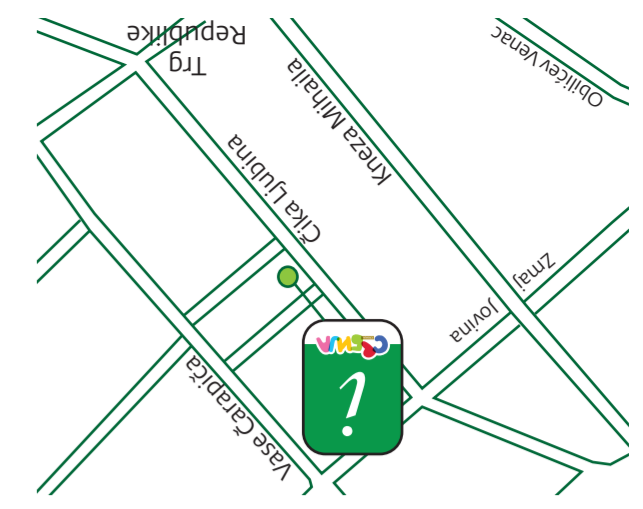
### PASSPORTS AND VISAS
